

Rule on Priority Registration for Student in the University Honors Program

To be eligible for priority registration by class students in the University Honors Program must either

- have taken enough Honors courses to be on track with their academic standing (that is – 2 Honors courses by the end of freshman year, 4 Honors courses by the end of sophomore year, or 6 Honors courses by the end of junior year),
- or have fulfilled all Honors course requirements (with the exception of Honors Capstone),
- or have taken at least two Honors courses during the prior academic year.

Honors students in their first year who have matriculated are eligible for priority registration if they are enrolled in or have completed at least one Honors course.

Honors students on probation in the University Honors Program or who did not attend the University Honors Program Conference are not eligible for priority registration.
