Chapman uses EthicsPoint as one of our tools for addressing misconduct and other concerns at work.
EthicsPoint allows us to make this process anonymous and confidential.

Tips and Myths of Reporting

- All interactions with EthicsPoint are anonymous (unless you choose to identify yourself). Calls are not traced or recorded, and EthicsPoint does not maintain any internal connection logs with IP addresses.
- Check in at EthicsPoint using your report key & password to track the investigation from beginning to end or to communicate with the University anonymously during the investigation.
