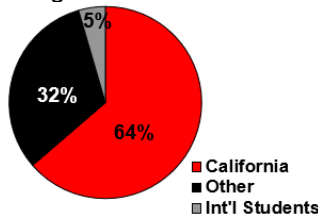

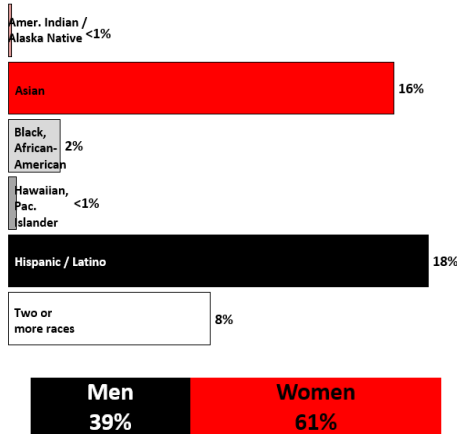

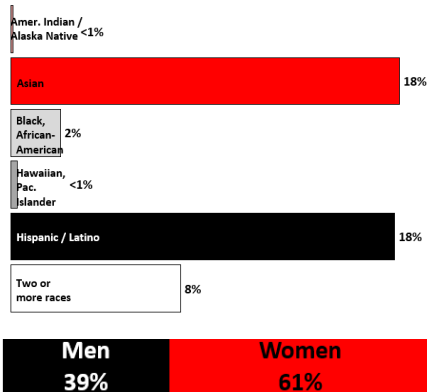
Geographic Origin



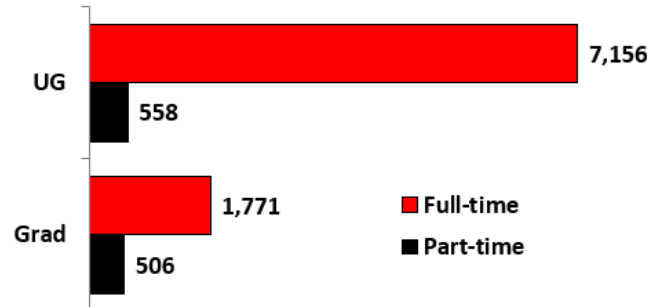
Diversity of Fall '21 Full-time Undergrads

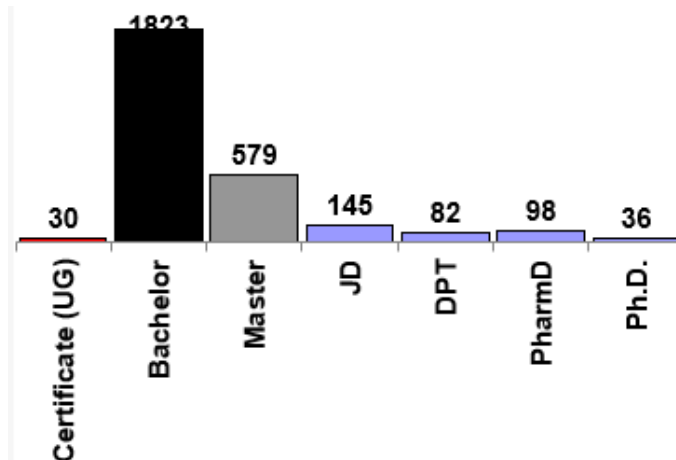

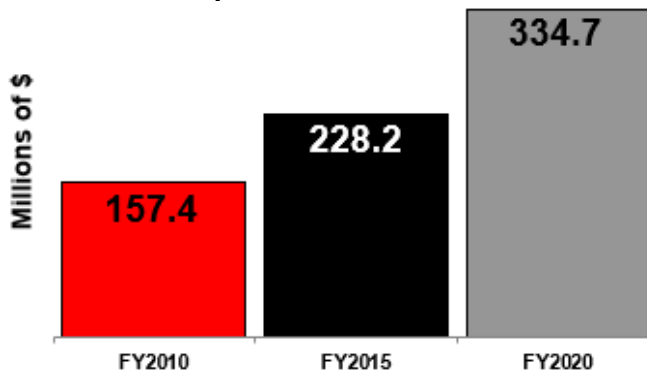

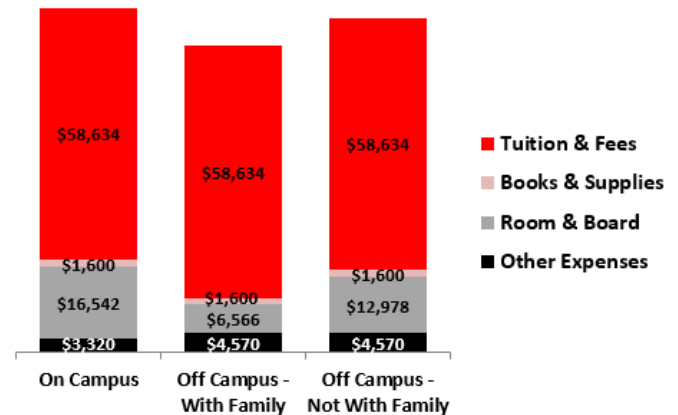

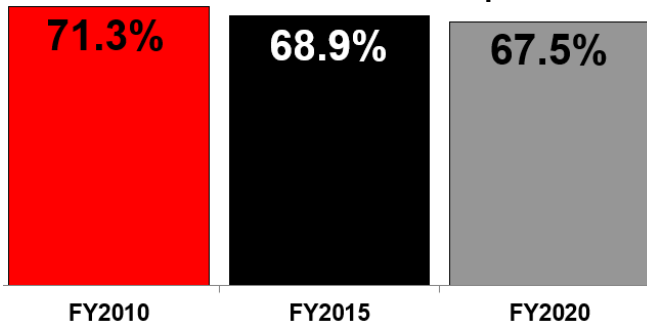
Educational Expenditures



Estimated Costs of Attendance (2021-22 Undergraduates)



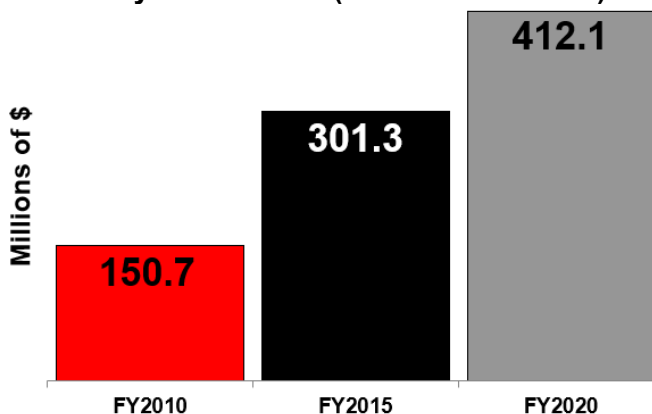
Instruction and Academic Support Expenses as Percent of Total Educational Expenses
