

## Latinx Forum Bylaws (Adopted 9-6-18)

#### **Highlights:**

- With the exception of the chair, all officers serve twoyear terms. The chair serves one additional semester as past-president to help with the transition.
- Terms start January 1st and end December 31st.
- All active members on the membership list employed by Chapman University retain the right to vote for new officers during elections.
- Latinx Forum co-founders shall become ex-officio members of the Executive Board as Founding Board Member, Emeritus.






