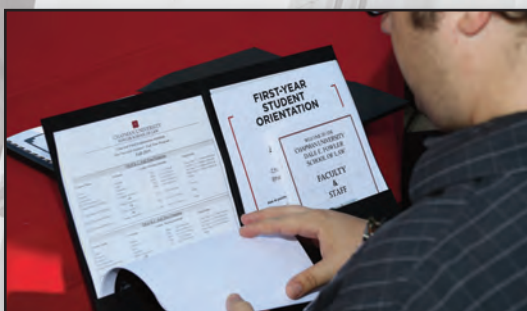

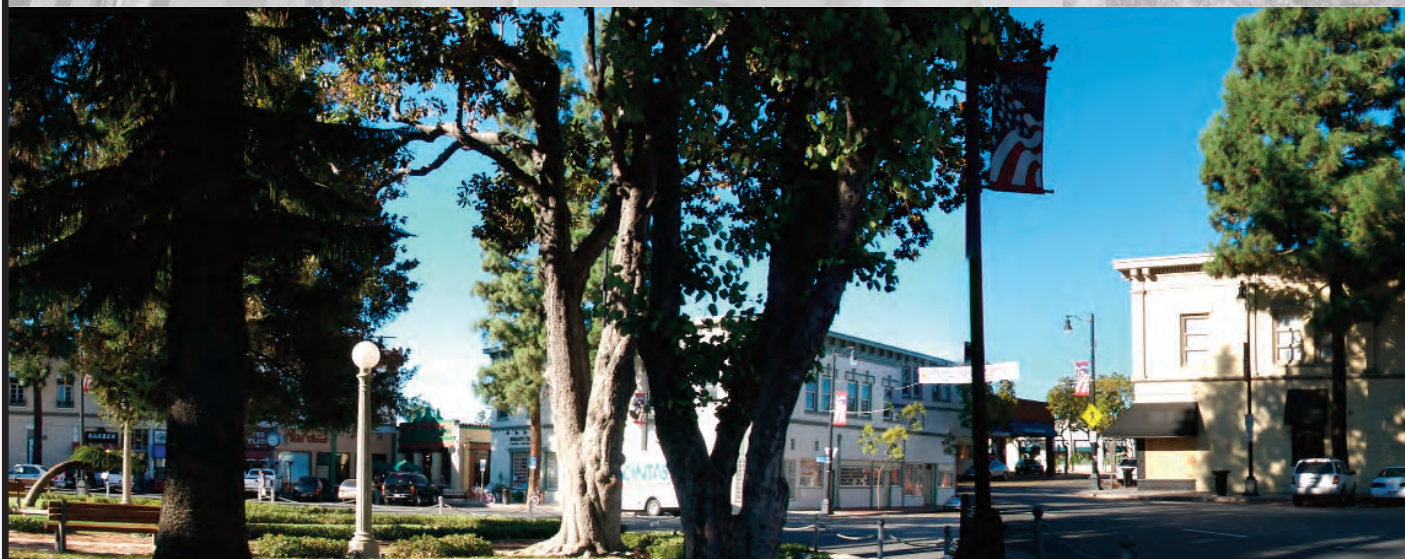

Remember that the attire for Launch Week is “business casual.”

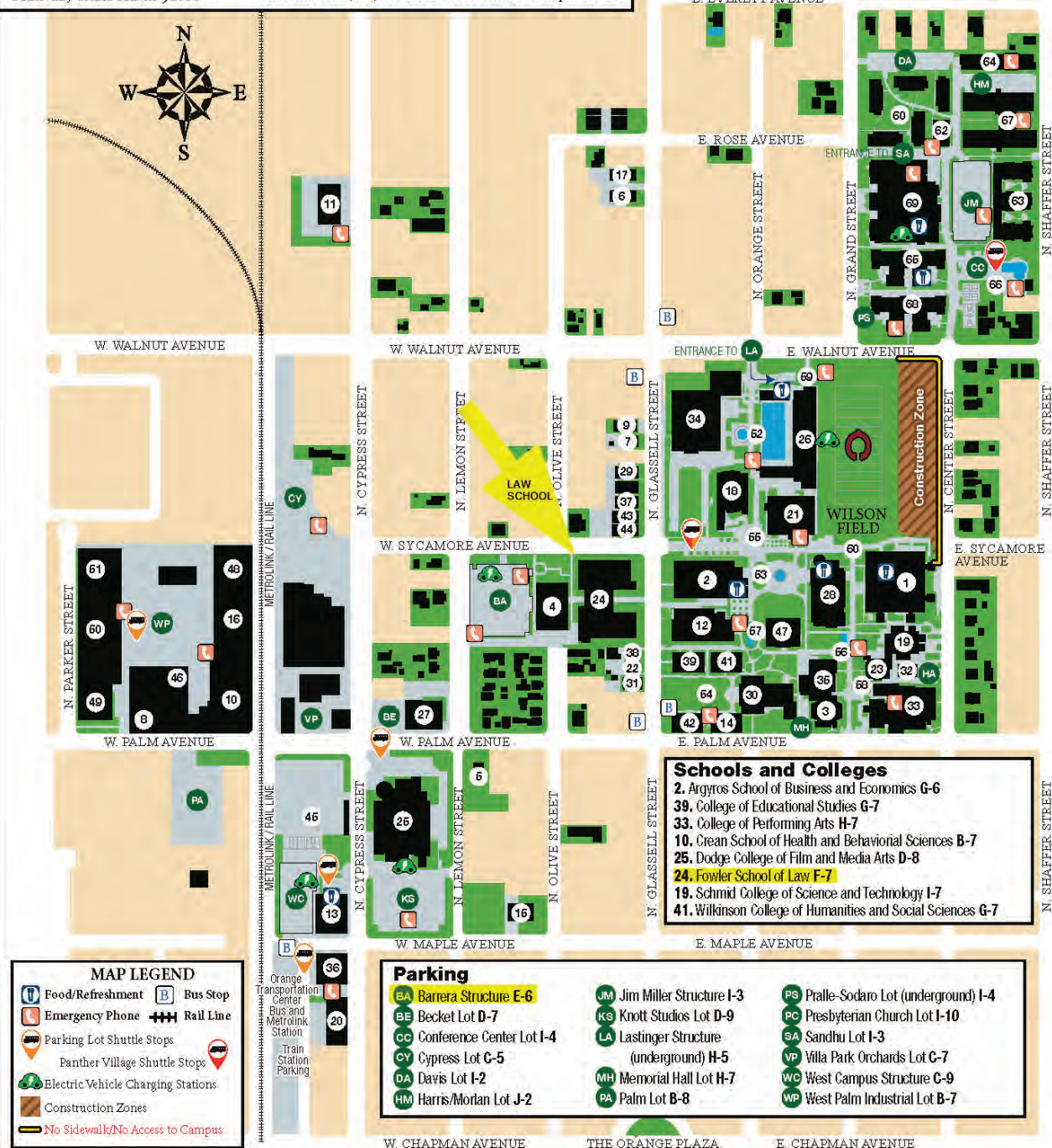
