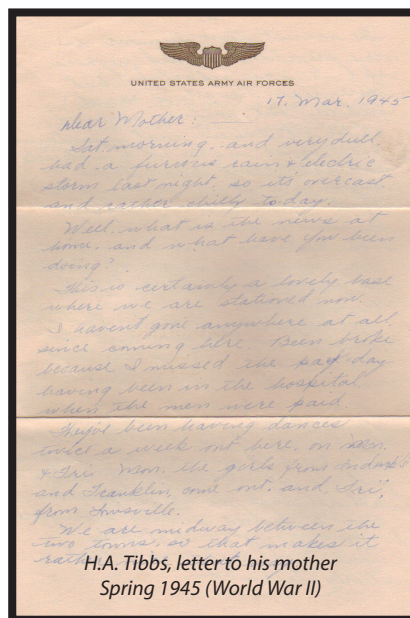

Howard Tibbs was a jazz/swing tenor saxophonist who performed with the Army Air Force bands and USO shows at segregated bases and cities around the nation in the 1940s.
