

Majoring and Minoring in Graphic Design

The Graphic Design program is rigorous and challenging, emphasizing conceptual design methods, appropriate aesthetics, history, writing development, verbal articulation, and training in technology that prepare the student to enter the graphic design profession. Students have opportunities to explore all aspects of graphic design, such as packaging, illustration, information design, advertising design, web design, multimedia design, and book design. Courses include numerous visiting lecturers and professionals, field trips, gallery shows and realworld client projects.
