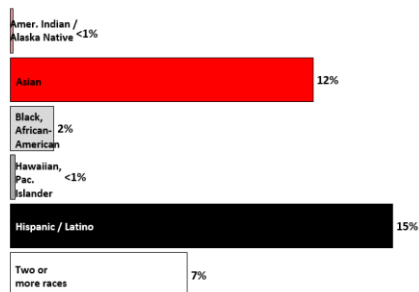

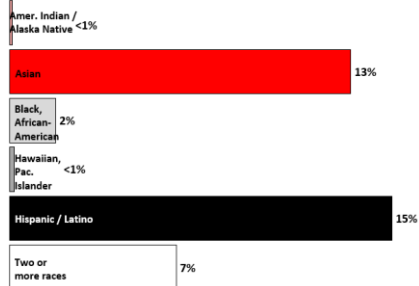
### Geographic Origin



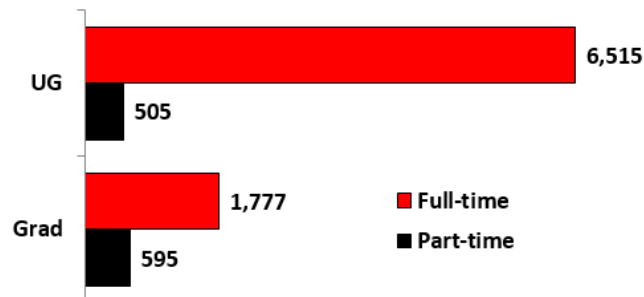
### Diversity of Fall '17 Undergrads

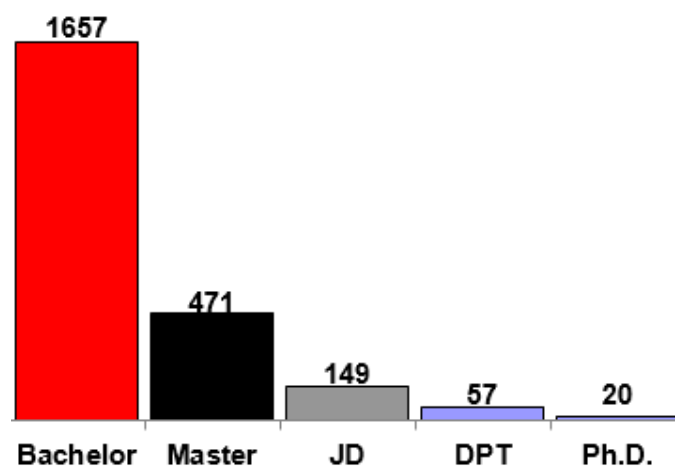

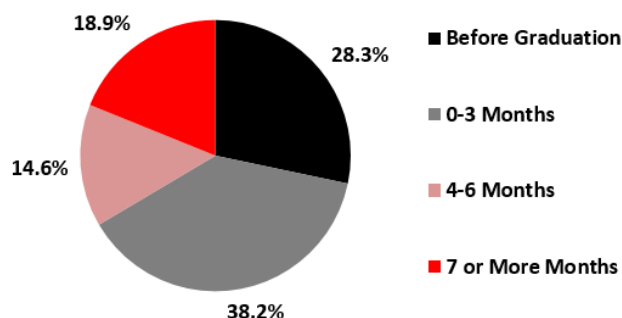

## Time Elapsed From Graduation to Acceptance of Full-time Employment (2015-16 Undergraduate Degree Recipients)



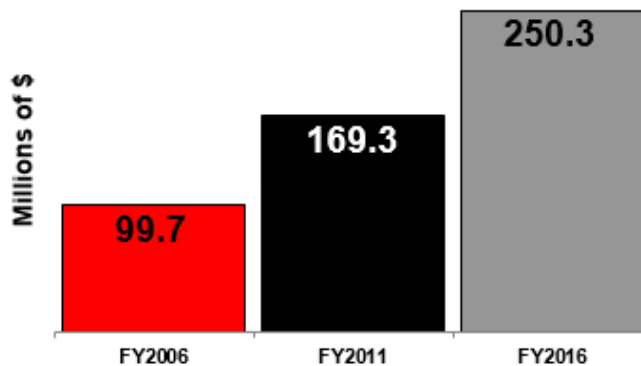

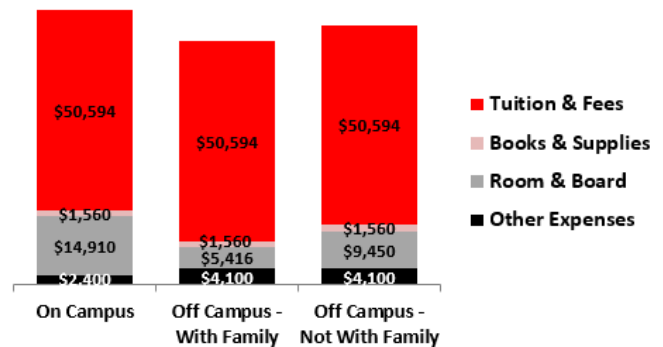

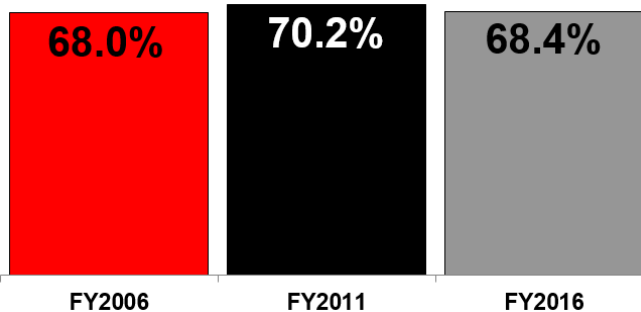
## Educational Expenditures

## Instruction and Academic Support Expenses as Percent of Total Educational Expenses

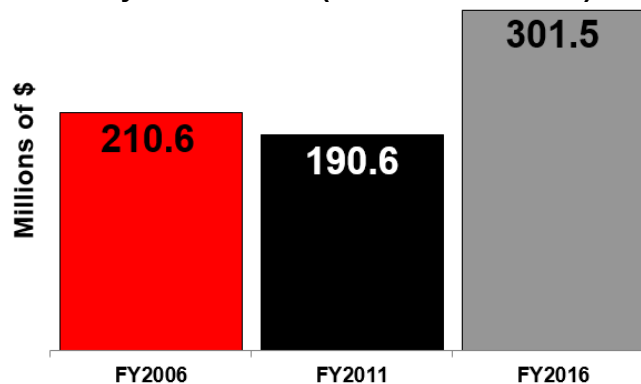
