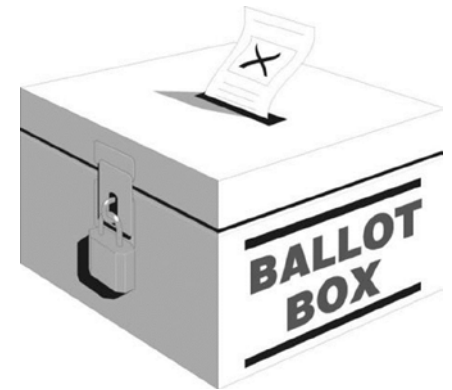

# Latinx Forum Bylaws (Adopted 9-6-18)

---

## Highlights:

- With the exception of the chair, all officers serve two-year terms. The chair serves one additional semester as past-president to help with the transition.
- Terms start January 1<sup>st</sup> and end December 31<sup>st</sup>.
- All active members on the membership list employed by Chapman University retain the right to vote for new officers during elections.
- Latinx Forum co-founders shall become ex-officio members of the Executive Board as Founding Board Member, Emeritus.



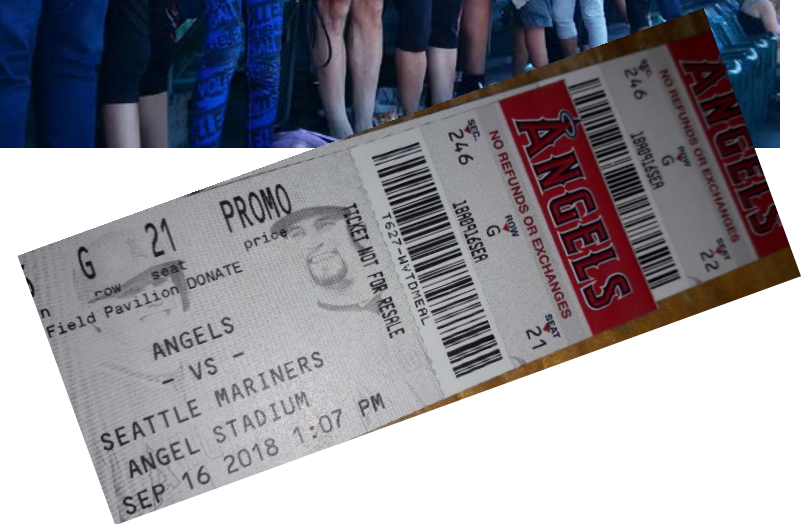

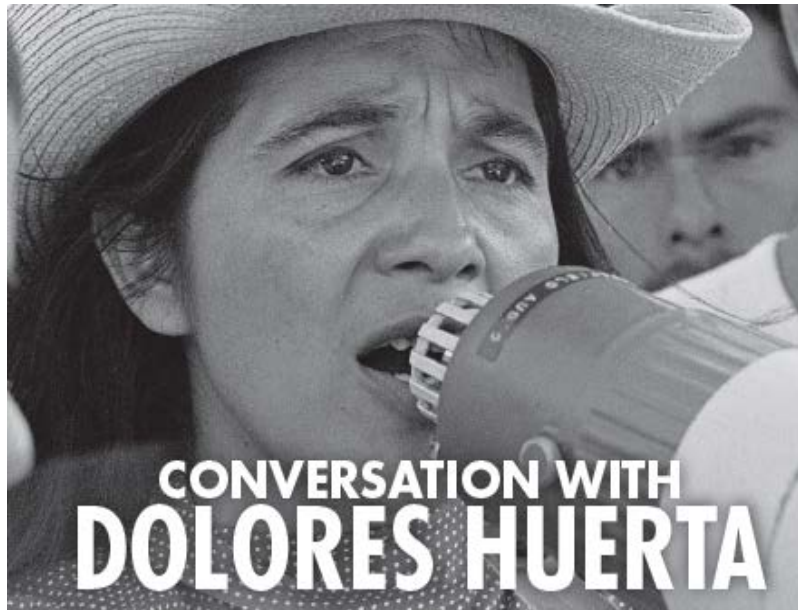
