

## **Neighborhood Advisory Committee Summary Feb. 9, 2018 Meeting**

The Neighborhood Advisory Committee met on Friday, February 9, 2018 at the Rinker Health Science Campus in Irvine.

### **Tour of Academic Programs**

The Committee received tours of the School of Pharmacy from Dean Ron Jordan and the Crean College of Health and Behavioral Sciences from Dean Janeen Hill.

### **Rinker Campus Overview**

Jack Raubolt reported that the Rinker campus consists of six buildings, five of which are two-story, one of which is four stories. Total square footage for the buildings adds up to over 406,000. Furthermore, there are over 2,000 parking spaces available for students, staff, and faculty bringing the total square footage of the campus to roughly 535,000 or roughly twenty-four acres.

### **Construction Updates**

#### **Keck Center for Science and Engineering**

Jack Raubolt reported that the Keck Center project is on target for opening in fall 2018 as scheduled. As of February 2018, fire alarm systems and doors and hardware are being installed. All lab casework was complete as of January.

#### **Chapman Grand**

Jack Raubolt reported that the University's recent acquisition of a student housing facility in Anaheim, Chapman Grand, is on schedule to open for fall 2018. The residence hall will offer 900 beds once complete.

#### **VPO Residential Village and Restoration**

Jack Raubolt reported that phase one of the project, the relocation of historic sheds, is complete. Phase two is currently in progress with the start of construction for the Residential Village scheduled for March or April. The target completion date for the residence hall is August 2019 and when complete, will house approximately 400 students. Phase three, the Packing Plant restoration, is also in progress. The University anticipates that the project will begin in late spring with a projected completion date of summer 2019. The Packing Plant itself will house student services and academic rooms, while still maintaining the same exterior historical façade.
