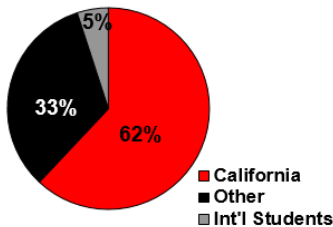

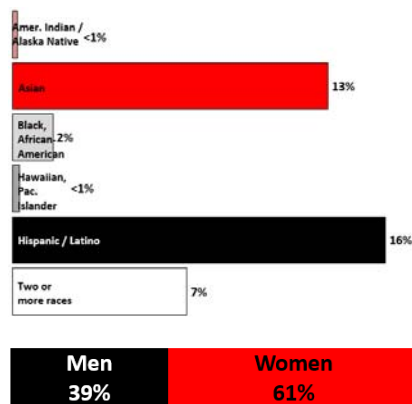

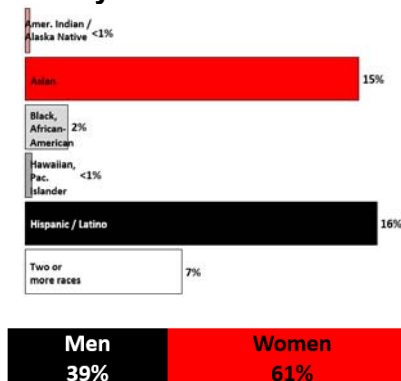
Geographic Origin



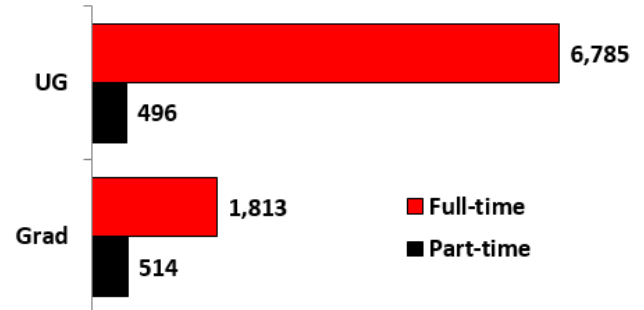
Diversity of Fall '18 Undergrads

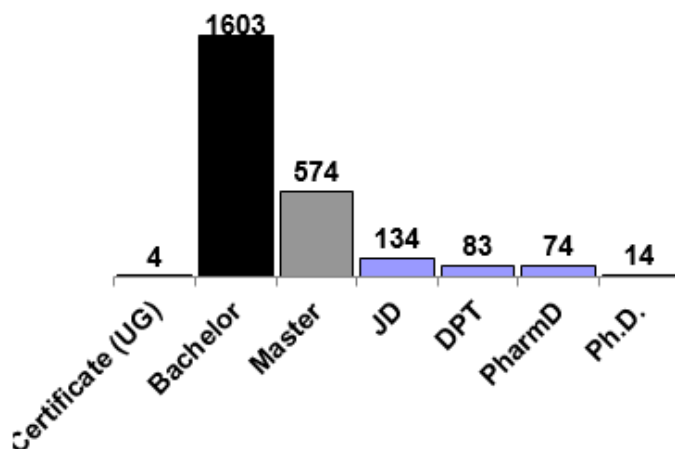

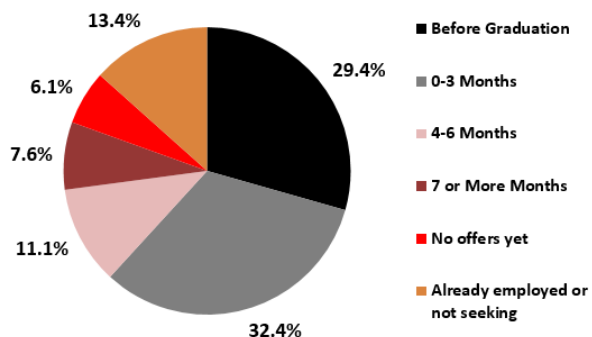

Time Elapsed From Graduation to Acceptance of Full-time Employment (2016-17 Undergraduate Degree Recipients)



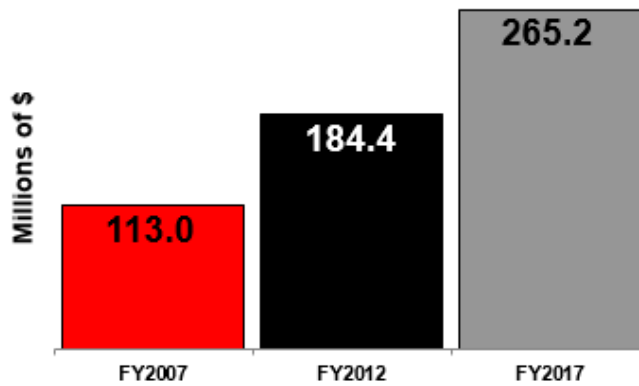

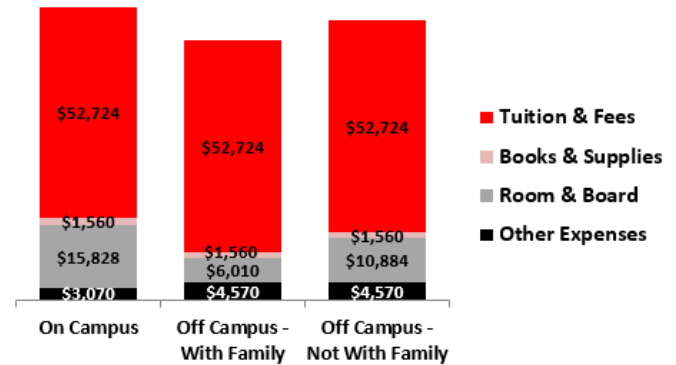

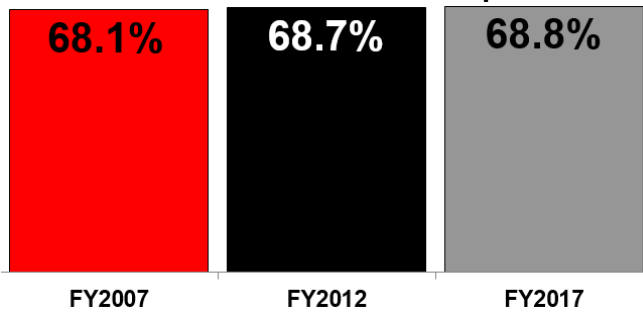
Educational Expenditures



Estimated Costs of Attendance (2018-19 Undergraduates)



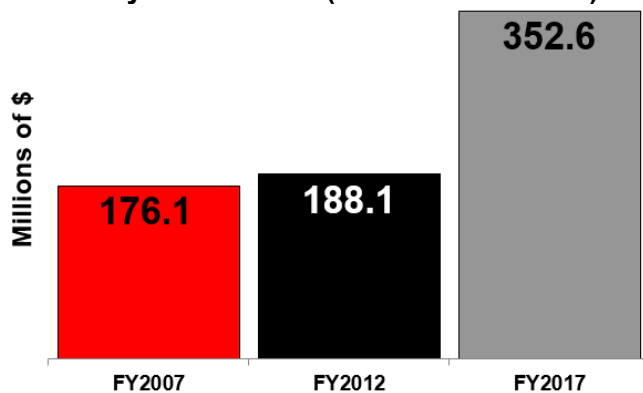
Instruction and Academic Support Expenses as Percent of Total Educational Expenses
