

# Graduate Achievement Data

To comply with requirements set by the Commission on Accreditation for Marriage and Family Therapy Education (COAMFTE), Chapman University's Marriage and Family Therapy program provides a yearly report to the commission showing relevant program information including Graduate Achievement Data (GAD). The GAD table below contains data for the past 7 academic years, or 7 cohorts. Job placement rate is collected on an annual basis through the Annual MFT Alumni Survey distributed each January. These percentages are based on the number of graduates who reported the requested information to the program. Response rates vary per cohort.

**Advertised Graduation Rate:** Shows the percentage of students from the cohort year who graduated from the program within the advertised length of completion. Students enrolled in this program are expected to complete all requirements within 3 years.

**Job Placement Rate:** Shows the percentage of graduates from the cohort year listed that are currently employed utilizing skills learned in the COAMFTE accredited program.

**Licensure Rate:** Shows the percentage of graduates from the cohort year that have achieved ANY level of MFT licensure. For Master's programs only, COAMFTE has established a benchmark of 70% licensure rate for each cohort.
