

DACA: Update and Campus Resources

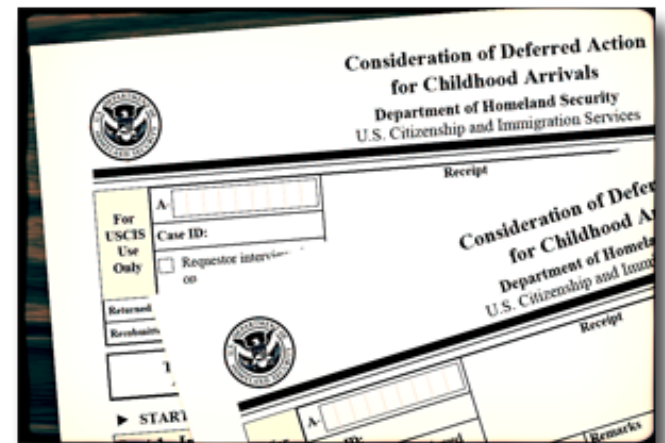
○ Current State (per Janine DuMontelle as of 1-17-18)

- Last week the US District Court issued a temporary injunction halting plans to end DACA. The judge ordered the government to resume renewing DACA and work authorizations and Homeland Security officials said they would comply.
- Rather than let the court review it the Justice Department has asked the US Supreme Court to intervene. There is no word yet on whether the US Supreme Court will take it or how they will decided it if they do.
- The Justice Department did not request a stay of the US District Court's ruling.

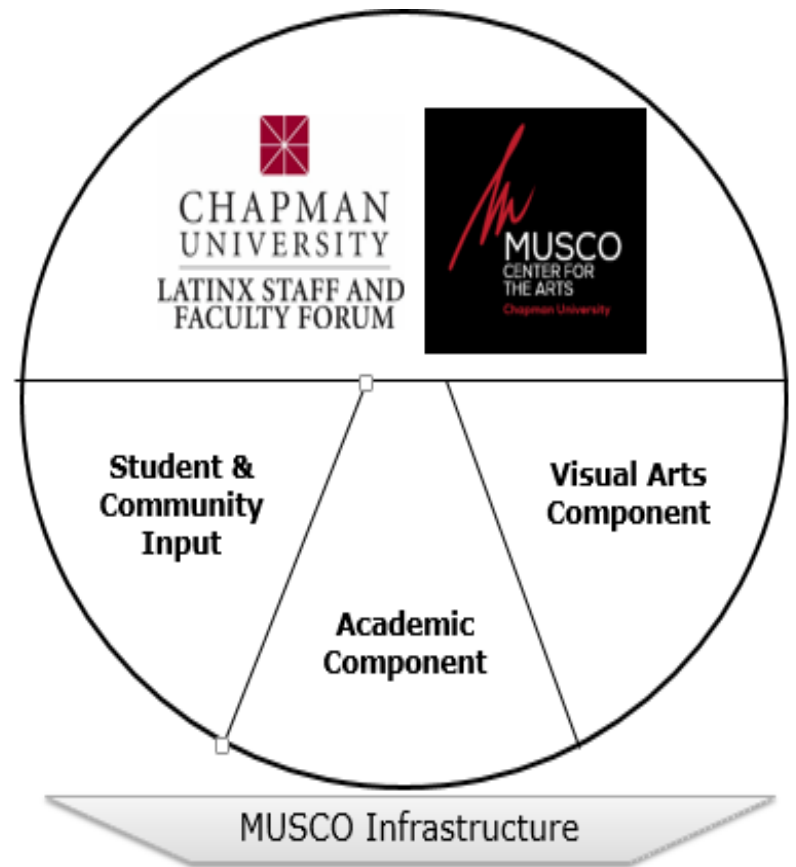

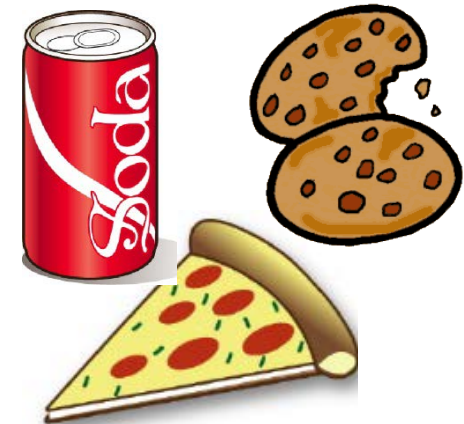
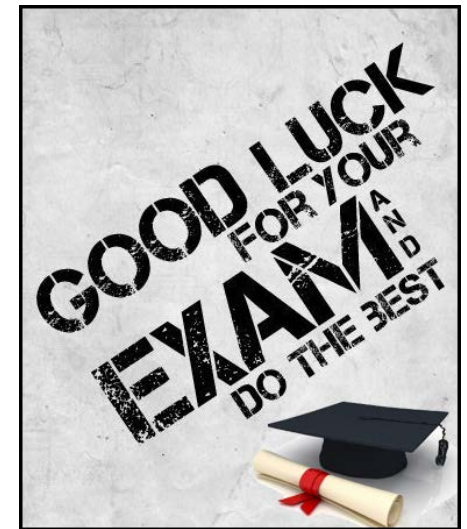
