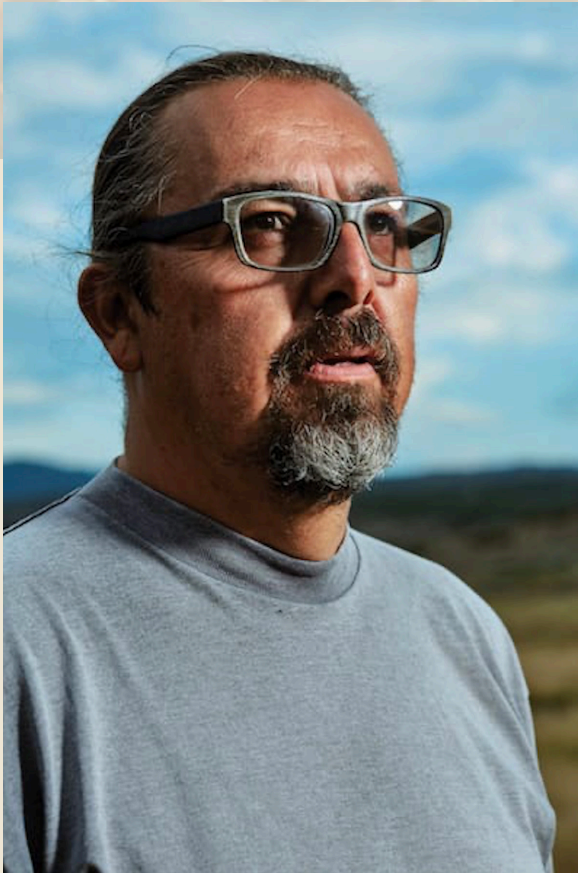

As a visual artist, Gerald Clarke has exhibited his work extensively and in numerous exhibitions as well as in major museum collections. In 2007, Gerald was awarded an Eiteljorg Museum Fellowship for Native American Fine Art and served as an Artist-in-Residence at the Institute of American Indian Arts in Santa Fe, New Mexico in 2015. Earlier this year, Gerald received a Harpo Foundation Native American Fellowship to the Vermont Studio Center.

In 2022 The Escalette Permanent Art Collection added two of Clarke's works, *One Tract Mind: Baskets* (2009) and *The United States of Amnesia II* (2017), to the collection, through the generosity of the Ellingson Family.
