Students must take the following core classes in History to complete their history major.

- HIST 296 History Seminar (3 credits)
- HIST 398 The Historian's Craft (3 credits)
- HIST 496 Advanced Research Thesis I (3 credits)
- HIST 498 Advanced Research Thesis II (3 credits)

In addition to, four 100-level classes (12 credits), three 200-level classes (9 credits), and four 300-level (12 credits) history classes of your choice.

**Totaling: 15 History Classes (45 credits)**

At least eight 100-200 level classes

At least seven 300+ level classes

Chapman University requires 42 upper-division credits, and 21 credits will be from your history major.

<b>FIRST YEAR</b>			<p>Enroll in 100–200 level history classes.</p> <p>History majors need to take four 100-level classes and three 200-level classes.</p>
<b>SECOND YEAR</b>	HIST 296		<p><b>Enroll in HIST 296 in the Fall</b></p> <p>and continue with 100–200 level history classes.</p> <p>Consider studying abroad or taking a travel course.</p>
<b>THIRD YEAR</b>		HIST 398	<p>Enroll in 300-level history classes. History majors need to take four 300-level history classes.</p> <p><b>Enroll in HIST 398 in the Spring.</b></p> <p>Consider studying abroad or taking a travel course.</p>
<b>FOURTH YEAR</b>	HIST 496	HIST 498	<p><b>Enroll in HIST 496 and 498 your senior year.</b></p> <p>Enroll in 300-level history classes.</p>
