Compostable:

- Fruit
- Vegetables
- Bread + Grains + Rice
- Dairy products
- Eggs
- Meat + Poultry + Bones
- Seafood + Shelfish

NON-Compostable:

- Plastic
- Cans
- Glass
- Paper + Cardboard
- Packaging
- Oil + Grease

How to dispose of food waste

The Office of Sustainability and Chapman Grand present a new

composting program by Republic Services. Step 1: Find a container, bag or bin to dedicate for compost in your apartment.

Step 2: Keep your bin in food prep areas near the sink or in the freezer and place all food waste in it.

Step 3: When your bin gets full, take it to the trash room and place the compost in the food waste bin (no other waste or recycling).

Step 4: Republic Services and Aramark staff will then collect all food waste in order to compos it properly in their facilities usin an anaerobic digester.
